- Explore Maria Island, perhaps catching site of native pademelons – Forester Kangaroos, Bennetts Wallabies and Tasmanian Devils.
- Partake in a behind the scenes tour of the Port Arthur Historic Site – Australia's most intact and evocative convict site.
- Sample gourmet produce and boutique cool climate wines.
- Enjoy the comfort of a classic small ship with no more than 46 guests.
