


# Small ship cruising

## in 2019 & 2020

Cruising has become so popular that to secure cabins, we must book early especially on small ship and expedition cruising.

To hold a group allocation of cabins, we need to make a commitment about a year ahead. The advantage of this is that the price of cabins is often more reasonable the earlier we book them. ### CRUISES FOR 2019

#### March/April 2019: Adelaide and the Murray River

##### CONFIRMED DEPARTURE

Enjoy the *MS Murray Princess* for a three night cruise on the Murray River. Your small riverboat is the largest inland paddle wheeler in the southern hemisphere. This cruise is part of our short break to Adelaide.

#### July 2019: Family adventure along the Mekong

Take your grandchildren on an overseas adventure during the July school holidays. Children travel free for seven nights aboard the *Mekong Pandaw*. Cruise the Mekong River from the Vietnam Delta into Cambodia. With only 18 upper deck and six main deck staterooms, travel in style with high levels of service.

#### Oct/Nov 2019: Nepal and Cruising the Ganges

Spend 7 nights aboard the *Kalaw Pandaw* cruising the Hooghly River as part of our tour to Nepal and West Bengal. This rivership provides a comfortable way to explore off the beaten track in India.

#### Nov 2019: Peru and the Amazon

After exploring Peru, cruise the remote upper reaches of the Amazon River, with luxury accommodation on board the *MV Delfin III* offering 22 suites with the highest levels of comfort for up to 43 passengers.

Accommodating a maximum of 72 passengers, the *Coral Discoverer* can go where larger vessels cannot. The ship has an onboard tender vessel which can seat all passengers for excursions to beaches and rivers. Cruising offers a new way to explore the South Island. Confirmed departure.

## PROPOSED NEW CRUISES FOR 2020

### Jewels of the South Seas, March 2020

Board *Le Soleal*, a luxury small ship holding up to 264 passengers and cruise for 13 days stopping at Papeete, Bora Bora, Aitutaki, Wallis and Futuna, Samoa and Lautoka. We are holding a cabin allocation until 20 March 2019.

### Madagascar, Reunion & Mauritius, April 2020

A brand-new expedition cruise in the Indian Ocean. From the Seychelles to Mauritius via Madagascar and Reunion Island. Discover places of breath-taking natural beauty that few tourists visit. Aboard *Le Lyrial*, another of the Ponant luxury small ships which holds up to 224 passengers.

### Arctic Explorer August 2020

Explore the best of Greenland and Nunavut in the height of summer on this 12-day cruise aboard the *Ocean Endeavour*, an expedition ship with a passenger capacity of 199. Visit the stunning west coast of Greenland and learn about Franklin's doomed attempt to complete the Northwest Passage and see where the abandoned ships lie.
